



Preah Vihear Church Plant/ Education Project

Toul Khpous Village, Preah Vihear ([13°46'42.2"N 105°14'58.2"E](#))

Toul Khpous is home to 46 families, totaling 183 people. There are 45 primary school-aged children (23 girls), who currently must walk nearly 4 kilometers daily to access the nearest school. This presents a significant barrier to their consistent education and well-being, particularly during the rainy season. In response to this need, a small discipleship group of 28 members has formed in the community, led by Pastor. Ra Sopheap. With strong support from the local village chief and community, we aim to establish a permanent school structure that will provide safer, more accessible, and consistent education. The community is also partnering with labor and materials.

Partner with Mission 25 so we can seize this opportunity to provide support to these communities and tangibly share the love of Jesus.
