Ah Toa, Odar Meanchey ([14°04'30.8"N 103°48'20.7"E](#))

Cambodia has been facing urgent educational needs since the Khmer Rouge genocide of the 1970s. Economic necessity forces most able-bodied adults to seek work in other provinces or even abroad, with many traveling to countries such as Malaysia, Thailand, or Korea; others take construction jobs in Phnom Penh. This migration leaves children in the care of their grandparents, leaving most children unable to attend school. The recent border crisis in Cambodia has compounded these issues.

Odar Meanchey Province desperately needs solutions. In the village of Ah Toa, due to the ongoing issues at the border, there is a large group of displaced Cambodians with very few options for education. The good news is that this gives Mission 25 a unique opportunity to provide education with a safe learning & community hub, clean water with a well, and the love of Jesus with a church!

Partner with Mission 25 so we can seize this opportunity to provide support to these communities and tangibly share the love of Jesus.

- Building Size: 8m x 12m
- The building will be split into 2 classrooms (room size 6mX4m)
- Church meeting hall
- ceiling, Lighting, and fans
- Roof: Metals and zinc
